

How to Dust



1. Gather supplies:
 - Clean cloth
 - Broom
 - Vacuum
 - Dusting wand (e.g., feather, Swiffer®)
 - Optional: multi surface wipes or furniture spray
2. Have a plan.
 - Have a specific path through the house to make sure you dust everything. Clear room of clutter (e.g., newspapers, dishes).
3. Move clockwise or counterclockwise through the room.
4. Using damp cloth or wipe, wipe away dust.
5. Move objects as you go and clean surfaces underneath thoroughly.
6. Carefully wipe down objects.

7. Shake or rinse cloth regularly.
8. Use a dusting wand for hard to reach places.
9. Vacuum and mop floors if needed. *Note: Do not use furniture polish on floors.*
